The green space/park is a destination serving as a retreat and gathering place within Downtown. The multi-use facility lends itself to a wide variety of activities for people of all ages and interests. The site is a venue for concerts, theatre performances, cultural events, festivals, weddings and reunions. Carolina Wren Park is operated by the City of Anderson and is maintained by the City of Anderson Parks and Recreation Department. It is open sunrise to sunset.*

4. COURTYARD: The building located on the right of the park offers additional seating/programming space. The original building's front facade remains and allows pedestrian access from E. Whitner Street.

- Maximum number of persons seated is approximately 155, standing is 285.
- The rental fee is \$450 for 4 hours, and includes 6 tables with umbrellas and 24 chairs.

5. AMPHITHEATER: The amphitheater incorporates a green lawn and low stone walls on which to sit. Located next to the monumental staircase, it makes a grand entrance into the park.

- Maximum number of persons seated is 240, standing is 460.
- The rental fee is \$650 for 4 hours.

Facilities

1. WREN PAVILION: The red brick building located on the left of the park houses storage, restrooms, a warming kitchen for events, and functions as an open air pavilion for the park.

- Maximum number of persons seated is approximately 174, standing is 374.
- The rental fee is \$550 for 4 hours.

2. STAGE/SPRAY PLAZA: The Stage/Spray Plaza is the focal point of the park. It includes the water wall and interactive splash pad which offers LED lighting and music integration. This feature gives the opportunity to offer a scripted water and light show.

- Maximum number of persons seated is approximately 565, standing is 1,212.
- The rental fee is \$950 for 4 hours
- The interactive splash pad can be operational for an additional \$100.

3. OVERLOOK: The overlook provides a great view of the beautifully landscaped park.

- Maximum number of persons seated is approximately 472, standing is 1,011.
- The rental fee is \$650 for 4 hours

The rental fee includes onsite staff to handle any operations and maintenance duties related to the park. Any additional table and chair rentals will be obtained by the City and costs will be paid by the renter. Renter is responsible for payment of Security Officers if alcohol is served. General liability and or liquor liability insurance is required.
